# *A Message In A Bottle.*



Imagine decorating a glass bottle and writing a message to someone you love to put inside. A keepsake to be treasured whenever you thought about that person, or wanted to remember exactly how you felt after they were gone.

This was the task given to our teen groups one evening. First they spent a great deal of time, intricately painting their bottles in wonderful colors with special glass paint. Everyone detailed their bottles in their own special way. Next it was time to write a message to the loved one that they lost.

The notes were written on parchment paper. The messages could be as long, or as short as each person wanted to make them. There were no other guidelines, just write what is in your heart. Some messages were only a page long, but many were two and three page letters expressing their feelings and thoughts.

Once this part of the project was complete, it was time to place their messages in their beautiful bottles. Everyone had a choice. They could roll their pages like a scroll, tie them with a ribbon and place them in their bottle. This option allowed the teens to take out the letter and read it whenever they chose. The other option was to roll their pages up tightly, place them inside the bottle and let them unfurl. Choosing this option meant they did not intend to look at the words on paper again, but to remember how they felt when they wrote the message.

The project was very moving and symbolic for everyone and the teen groups loved it. The counselors and facilitators were amazed at just how involved everyone became in this project. "It just really seemed to capture their imaginations and to bring their feelings out," said Kathy Telger, Grief Counselor at The WARM Place.

That was a little over a year ago and the counselors would love to repeat the project with the new teen groups. However, the bottles, which were donated to us for the last project, are costly. Each bottle is \$3.00 and when you need 100, the project gets to be expensive. We are looking for a source to donate more bottles, but so far have not had any luck. If any of you know of a source or would be willing to underwrite a project such as Message In A Bottle, please let us know.

# The Playhouse of Dreams.

One day while flipping through a children's toy catalog something special caught Gay McWhorter's eye. There were pictures of adorable playhouses in all shapes and sizes. Gay, who has been a WARM Place Grief Counselor for ten years, had been thinking about donating something special for the new WARM Place home.

After reading that you could design a custom playhouse as a replica of your own house, she knew she had found the perfect gift. "I wanted to do something special for all of the children," said Gay. So she contacted Lilliput Play Homes in Pennsylvania and sent them the artist's rendering of the future WARM Place home. After several conversations they were ready to go and everyone was very excited about the project.

Each detail of the WARM Place home was lovingly duplicated — the columns on the porch, the windows, the second story and the paint color. The wooden outside of the house was carefully routed to give the effect of real bricks. Even the roof tiles, which were left over from the main house, were shipped to Pennsylvania to be used on the playhouse.

The entire house was constructed in Pennsylvania, then disassembled, shipped via truck to Texas and reassembled in The WARM Place yard. A concrete slab was measured and poured for the playhouse at the same time as the sidewalks and porches on the main house. The playhouse was reconstructed on-site by Steve Chernicky and two of his co-workers from Lilliput Play Homes. The reassembly process took about one full day.

She has also furnished the house with a mailbox, a wooden stove and refrigerator, plastic dishes and play food. There is a ladder that leads to the second story loft and a small couch was added from one of the

children's rooms. Karen Harper, one of Gay's good friends, is even making a quilt for the couch.

Naturally, the children love the playhouse the best. But even the adults have commented that they wish they had a place like this to play in when they were young. What a wonderful gift, a place for children to play together and dream.
