Dear Friends,
The first warm day of 2007, I found myself sitting outside with two children that had experienced the death of their

Daddy. The girls were calm and shy when they began telling me about their Father. He was a Dad that was very close to his daughters. The girls wept as words could not express the depth of their sorrow over this significant loss. The only words they could say were, "The house seems empty now that Daddy isn't coming home."

I believe children that come to The WARM Place are extraordinary and they bring "magical" moments. Katie, age 6 and Susie, age 7 are exceptional young girls. We spent time walking through the house looking at all the pictures and quilts on the walls. The children began asking me very appropriate questions. Upon passing the donor box in the hallway, they stopped to ask me about it. I explained that many gracious people gave their money so that families could attend free of charge. As we were walking to the front door,

to add this money to it so we can

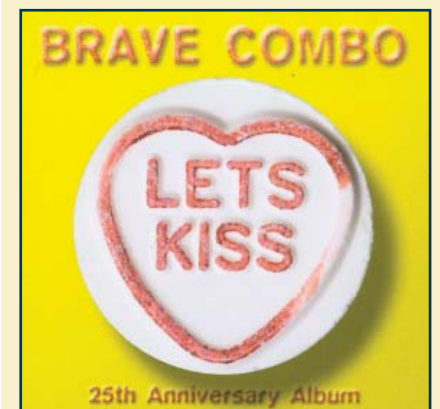
raffle and silent auction items when

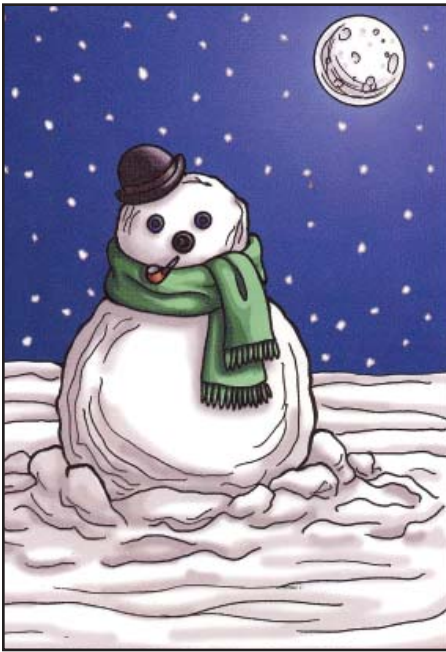
Brave Combo takes the stage!!!

In January, our counselors were inspired by a story written by Robin Helene Vogel, called "The Snowman," and decided to share it with our children, pre-teen and teen groups. In the story, two young brothers are outside on a cold winter night building a snowman together. The snowman is the first that Tommy and Buddy built since their Dad died. They have their Dad's old pipe, his favorite scarf and hat, and two big buttons for the eyes. The only thing missing is their Dad.

During the course of building the snowman, the boys begin to talk about their father and how much they miss him. Suddenly in the story the older brother, Tommy gets angry and yells at his little brother, "He was the best father in the world! I miss him! Talking about him this way makes me miss him so much and sometimes I can't help being mad at him for leaving us the way he did!" "Don't say that, Tommy!" Buddy pleaded. "You know it isn't true. We both loved him a lot. He couldn't help what happened! He didn't want to leave us!"

BUILDING THE FIRST SNOWMAN.

Both boys begin to cry, but eventually calm down. They talk for a long time and then the younger brother says, "Before you said you were mad at Dad for dying, are you still, Tommy? Don't you think he was the best daddy in the world?" Tommy says, "Of course I do. I just blew up, Buddy. It's okay to be angry when somebody dies, Mom said all our feelings are okay. I didn't mean to scare you. I just needed to get mad and cry. It hurt to build this first snowman without Dad to help."

After reading the story, the facilitators in each of the groups helped the boys and girls assemble their own snowmen. The snowmen were made out of white socks filled with rice and the children, pre-teens and teens decorated them in memory of their loved one. This was a new art activity and everyone was enthusiastic about getting to build their own "Snowman." While they were busy creating,

each group also shared stories about favorite times they shared with the person they knew who died. "It was a different type of art activity from anything we have ever done and led to some extremely moving conversations with the kids in the groups," said Donna DeGrand, WARM Place counselor.

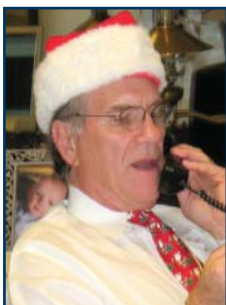

first year, while Ty, my middle son, wanted to talk about his Dad and what happened to him all the time. Trey was so young, he just became clingy and did not sleep well. I dealt with my husband's death by staying busy and trying to keep the boy's lives running smoothly. After completing a year of support group sessions at The WARM Place I could really see how beneficial it was to all of us. It was especially comforting to me to be able to talk to people who have been through this before. Through sharing and listening our entire family began to feel more “normal” again.

My husband was a firefighter so I lived with the fear that something could happen to him any day, at any time. In the back of my mind I always thought that I was prepared for the worst. I never even considered that my husband would be involved in a car accident when he was off duty. I soon learned that no matter how much I thought I had prepared myself for something to happen to him, I could not have been capable of conceiving the loss that I felt when Michael died.

I first came to The WARM Place with my three sons, Trey age 2, Ty age 5, and Tanner age 8 because I was so worried about my children and how they would learn to cope with the sudden death of their father. Tanner, my oldest son, did not want to talk about the death through the

I didn't really want to talk to anyone about my Dad dying for a long time, but coming to The WARM Place helped. It made it easier when the other kids shared their stories about their Mom or Dad dying, for me to talk about my Dad. It made me not feel so alone.

Ty, age 7

I miss my Dad so much and I like to talk about him. It's hard to think about not ever seeing him again and talking to the other boys and girls at The WARM Place has helped me not to be so sad.

Journey Through Grief.



Detour. One Way. Exit Now. All of these are familiar sayings that we see on signs as we travel through each day. In our Young Adult class last fall, the group of 19-25 year olds was asked to think about the grief process they were going through as a journey.

What signs would they see along the way? How would they travel on this journey? What vehicle would they take? What would the terrain look like? Who would be their fellow travelers? As the group began to discuss this idea, they began to discuss their "journey" in greater detail. They talked about the different ways each person was traveling through their grief.

One of the young adults said, "I feel like I am traveling in a fast car, speeding along." Another girl said, "I feel like I'm just walking so slowly, like I am hardly able to move." A young man in the group said, "I feel like I am climbing a rocky mountain that seems so high I will never reach the top." Their discussions led them through all types and modes of travel: a boat in a stormy sea, traveling in a plane above the clouds and not feeling a part of life, floating and drifting helplessly in a hot air balloon.

At the conclusion of their discussion they each received a blank sheet of paper, markers and foam cut-outs of various forms of transportation. Each young adult was asked to make a mural of where they were and how they were traveling and feeling on their grief journey. Their drawings brought out a lot of discussions about where each of them felt like they were on their trip. Everyone in the group agreed that this activity had brought up many feelings they didn't even realize they were having and that discussing them with their peers, who were on similar paths, was very beneficial.
